I have shown my dogs successfully in many countries. One of my dogs was the first of his breed to be shown in the US where he won numerous Best of Breeds.

I started judging in 1989 and it is not me who asked for the assignment. Indeed, it is my mentor, Guy MANSENCAL who announced that he had signed me up for the training of judges of the Soci  t   Centrale Canine, only two months before the assignment. I worked a lot during these two months to prepare. I had no right to disappoint my mentor and had to get the minimum score of 14/20 to continue my training as a judge. Very soon another great man of the canine world, Jean LESTIENNE asked me to judge the breeds for which he was the president of the breed clubs. And then gradually I extended my skills to other breeds.

Then I invested more in the canine world. I became a Show Chairman for shows in my area. I was president of several breed clubs. I was also secretary of the Soci  t   Centrale Canine (French Kennel Club).

Currently I am:

- President of the Poodle Club of France
- Chairman of the Club Saint Hubert du Nord, the canine society in the northern region of France.
- One of the five judges for all international breeds in France.
